# **General Call FFC Ricerca 2025 - eligibility**

- PI: must be affiliated with a Host Institution
   (HI) in a country that contributes patients to the European Cystic Fibrosis Registry (EU+)
- Multi-center projects are allowed

| PI      | Partner(s)      | Collaborator(s) |  |
|---------|-----------------|-----------------|--|
| Italian | everywhere      | everywhere      |  |
| EU+     | everywhere + at | everywhere + at |  |
| EUT     | least 1 Italian | least 1 Italian |  |

- PI and partners must have a permanent position;
- PI must have at least 3 papers as first/last/corresponding author in the last 5 years.



# Call FFC Ricerca 2025 – Budget

#### Budget and duration

- € 70.000 for one-year project
- € 130.000 for two-years project
- € 200.000 for three-years project

#### **Eligible costs**

- Small research equipment: max 7% of the total budget.
- Consumables and animals.
- Fellowships or research contracts (for graduates and technicians)
- Travel and scientific meeting participation: max 4% of the total budget.
- Publication expenses: max 2,5% of the budget
- Costs for patients: insurance coverage and travel costs.
- Overheads: max 3% of the total budget
- Occasional professional or technical services, expenses for clinical consultancy or patentability analysis: max 20% of
- the total budget.

#### **Ineligible costs**

- Salary for PI, Coordinators, Partners and internal or external collaborators
- Furniture and stationery articles.
- PC and other hardware.
- Software not specifically related to the project.
- Basic lab or clinical equipment (such as freezers, incubators, ovens, centrifuges etc.).
- Equipment repairing or technical assistance fees.
- Office materials

# «Gianni Mastella» Call: funding young investigators

The call is named after <u>Professor</u> <u>Gianni Mastella</u>, CF physician and scientist, co-founder of FFC Ricerca in 1997 and scientific director until his death in 2021.



- > The GM call is addressed to young untenured researchers
- The **budget** includes:
  - > a research contract for up to 3 years;
  - coverage of costs for research activity;
  - > the costs for a **training period**.
- > Two GM options are available.



# «Gianni Mastella» Call: two options

# Two funding options for young investigators:

- «Gianni Mastella» Starting Grant <u>GMSG</u> (under 40) addressed at investigators already operating in the field of CF, designed to facilitate the researchers scientific independence
- «Gianni Mastella» Research Fellowship <u>GMRF</u> (under 33)
   To start a career of a young researcher in the field of CF



# **GMSG** and **GMRF**: eligibility and features

# **Evaluation criteria of peer-review process**

- creativity and originality,
- potential value for the development of new knowledge,
- possible clinical implications,
- appropriateness of the study design,
- support of preliminary results,
- reliability of methods,
- feasibility in the context,
- feasibility in the indicated timeframe,
- adequacy of the economic resources requested,
- clarity and completeness of presentation

An updated database that classifies scientific publications on the effectiveness of clinical interventions in cystic fibrosis.









Valeria Capurro (Istituto G. Gaslini, Genoa)
